- Answer emergency and non-emergency calls for service from citizens
- Handle criminal and non-criminal reports and complaints
- Assist with various administrative functions such as testifying in court
- Work 12 hour shifts while on patrol
- Availability to work; days, nights, weekends, and holidays

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Possess good moral character
- Possess good reading and writing skills
- Possess a valid drivers license
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Have a record clear of any felonies and certain misdemeanors

- Attend GVSU/GRCC Police Academy (sponsorship only)
